Answers to this quiz demanded a little more explanation, so here goes:

1. Battle of the Atlantic – Sept. 1939 to May 1945.

2. The battle of Kursk.

Although it is commonly believed that the Enigma code was cracked at Blechtley Park by the English mathematician Alan Turing, it was in fact Marian Rejewski, a Polish mathematician and cryptologist at the Polish Cipher Bureau. This was in 1932, some seven years before the War started. The working pairs of Enigma machines, with full documentation, were later delivered to then Polish allies - France in June 1939 and England in August 1939. Work started in Bletchley during the war to crack the next generation of Enigma, after Germans introduced a fourth coding wheel, having realised that the Allies were reading their secure communication. Alan Turing and his team were then instrumental in braking the code of this updated Enigma, which by 1941 superseded the original design
