TABLE TENNIS TABLES REPLACEMENT

Current table tennis tables have been in use for over a decade and will soon be replaced by new ones, which are specifically designed for use in clubs, schools and sport centres.

They are much safer to fold and unfold, are suitable for wheelchair players and their playing surfaces will not be slammed against each other during set up and storage, as is the case with the current ones. They should last for some time given that they have a 3 year warranty and parts are to be available for 20 years.

Philip Ranger – current Australian Masters Table Tennis Champion

When I asked Phil Ranger, (one of the newest members who has joined our Table Tennis group) to take a photo of all his trophies and medals for this newsletter, Phil asked to give him some time. With career spanning several decades, there were so many spread around his house, that it was not something that could be done in a day or two. What you see in the picture below, is just what he brought from a recent trip over East, which happened last September / October.

Phil had disappeared from the Club for a month for a road trip from Canberra, through Melbourne to Adelaide. Lots of fishing and camping on the way, and while there, he also won 5 medals.

The three from Adelaide, were Australian Masters Gold Medals in Singles, in Teams and in Men's Doubles

Earlier on, he took part in National Veteran Championships in Canberra, where as part of the WA Team he defeated the favourites from New Zealand, but sadly lost to NSW. He came back with Silver Medal in Teams and Bronze in Doubles with Craig Campbell as doubles partner.

His presence has lifted the game level at the Club and most members are now significantly better than a year ago, before he joined. He is very approachable and always offers advice to anyone who asks.
